



BALMA SOFA

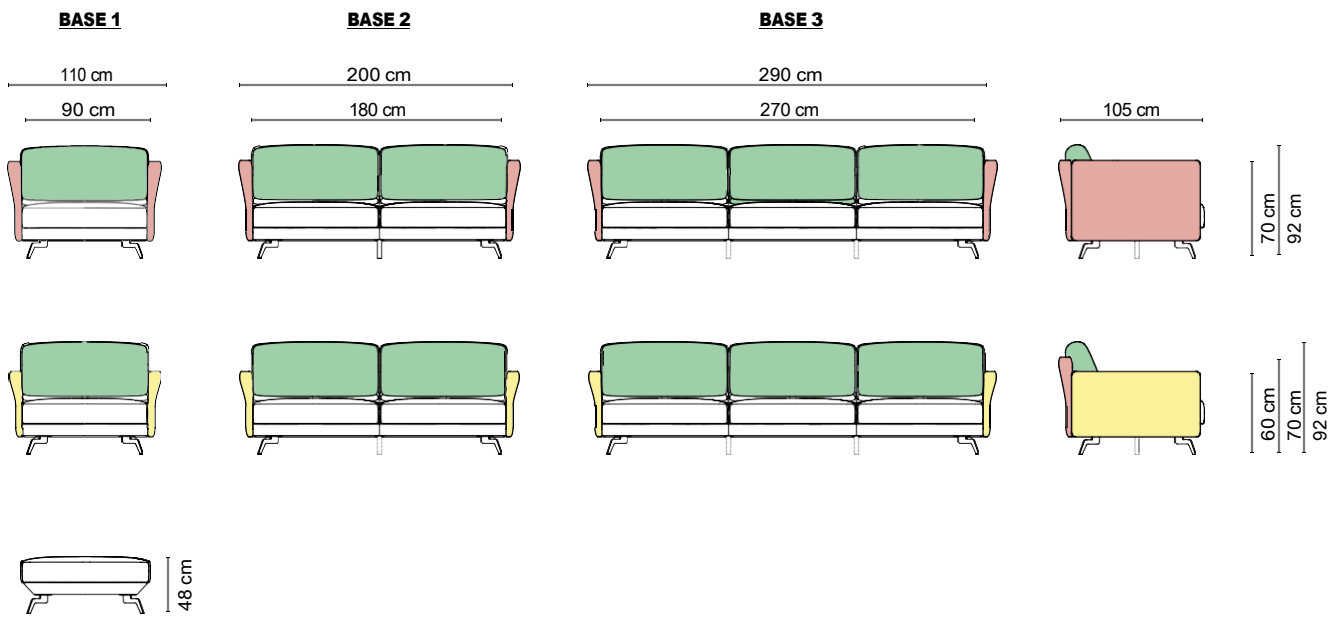

The Spanish word “balma” refers to a shallow cave shelter, a concavity in the rock formed by erosion and weathering, a natural refuge that can protect us in nature.

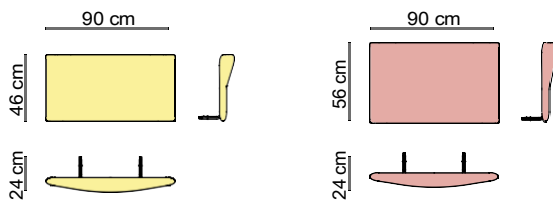

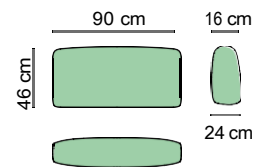
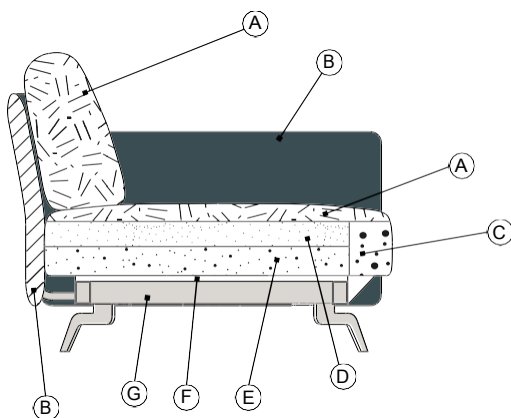
